A candidate taking an Assessor Training Ltd programme may be taught and/or assessed in other languages where it is to support a role in the workplace, providing that proficiency in English or Welsh is not required by the qualification specification. This allows candidates a fair and equal chance of demonstrating their knowledge, skills and understanding to achieve the assessment standards.

However, attention must be paid to awarding organisation language requirements if a formal qualification is associated with the training programme.

Use of English and Welsh

The Welsh Language Act 1993 established the principle that the English and Welsh languages should be treated on a basis of equality in Wales. Assessor Training Ltd will meet this legal requirement by providing access to bilingual (Welsh) assessors as necessary.

Process

The use of language (other than English and Welsh) is approached on a case by case basis and is subject to formal agreement by the senior management team, and where necessary the awarding organisation providing the qualification.

Candidates who have been assessed in another language may have this language stated on their qualification certificate.
